I. **Project Summary**

The Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, ("Town"), is soliciting bids from qualified licensed and bonded Firms; Contractors; and/or Consultants ("Contractor") to provide paving in accordance with the specifications set forth below.

III. **Project Requirements**

A bid bond or certified check in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total of the bid is required. Certified checks should be made payable to Town of Mount Carmel. The successful bidder will be required to execute acceptable Performance Bonds in an amount equal to one hundred (100%) percent of the contract price. Bid bonds/checks will be returned to unsuccessful bidders once a contract has been executed for the project with the successful bidder. If successful bidder refuses or neglects to execute a written contract and furnish security in the amount required within fifteen (15) days after being notified that the contract has been awarded, the certified check shall be forfeited to the Town as liquidated damages for such neglect or refusal, and the amount so collected shall be paid into the fund set aside for the Town's portion of the cost of the proposed improvement.

All bidders must be licensed Contractors as required by the Contractors Licensing Act of 1994 (TCA Title 62, Chapter 6).

By submission of a signed bid, the bidder certifies total compliance with Title VI and Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and all regulations promulgated thereunder.

Bids shall be clearly marked and identified on the exterior of the sealed envelope with all the information required by law, including the name of the project, "**MOUNT CARMEL STREET PAVING PROJECT – FY 26/27**", the bidder's name, address, license number, expiration date and classification.

All bids shall be signed, sealed, and addressed to Tyler Williams, Assistant Town Manager/CFO, ITB #26-001, Mount Carmel-Town Hall, 100 E. Main Street, P.O. Box 1421, Mount Carmel, Tennessee 37645, and marked as noted above.

No verbal, telephone, e-mail, or fax proposals will be considered. Late proposals will not be considered.

No submitted bids may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

The Town, by its governing regulations, reserves the right to accept or reject any or all

bids received, to waive any informalities in bidding and to re-advertise.

The successful contractor shall, within fifteen (15) days after being notified that the contract has been awarded, provide a Certificate of Insurance listing the Town of Mount Carmel as an additional insured. Contractor agrees to be insured for the minimum limits listed below:

By submitting a bid, Contractor acknowledges the insurance requirements and agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless the Town of Mount Carmel from any and all claims and suits for injury to persons or property arising out of the performance of the contract caused in any way by the acts or omissions of the contractor or the contractor's agents, employees, or subcontractor during or in connection with the contract work, excepting bodily injury or death or property damage caused by the sole negligence of the owner, its agents or employees.
