

ORDINANCE NUMBER 21 (Sample Ordinance)

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR NUMBERING PROPERTIES AND PRINCIPAL BUILDINGS IN THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARME.

THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Mount Carmel as follows:

* Section 1 - Uniform Numbering System

A uniform Numbering system of numbering properties and principal buildings, as shown on the map identified by the title Mount Carmel Numbering System Map which is filed in City Hall, is hereby adopted for use in the Town of Mount Carmel. This map and all explanatory matter thereon, is hereby adopted and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. - Assignment of Numbers

a. All properties or parcels of land within the corporate limits of Mount Carmel shall hereafter be identified by reference to the uniform numbering system adopted herein, provided; all existing numbers of property and buildings not now in conformity with provisions of this ordinance shall be changed to conform to they system herein adopted within six months from the date of passage of this ordinance.

b. A separate number shall be assigned for each 50 feet of frontage.

c. Each principal building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is located. In case a principal building is occupied by more than one business or family dwelling unit, each separate front entrance of such principal building shall bear a separate number.

d. Numeral indicating the official numbers for each principal building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.

Section 3 - Administration

a. The _____ shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system. In performance of his responsibility he shall be guided by the provisions of this ordinance.

b. The _____ shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this ordinance.

c. The _____ shall issue to any property owner in Mount Carmel upon request a set of numerals for each principal building or separate front entrance to such building. In doing so, he shall issue only numerals for the number assigned to such building under the provisions of this ordinance. Provided, however, that the recorder may issue additional numerals in accord with the official numbering system whenever a property has been subdivided, a new front entrance opened, or undue hardship has been worked on any property owner.

Section 4 - Penalties

Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and may be punished by a fine of \$1.00 to \$5.00. Each separate day such violation is continued shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 5 - Effective Dates

This ordinance shall take effect the day of its passage, the public welfare requiring it.
