

ORDINANCE NUMBER 61

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MOUNT CARMEL, HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE, PROHIBITING OPEN BEER OR INTOXICATING BEVERAGES IN PUBLIC PLACES INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS, AND PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MOUNT CARMEL, HAWKINS COUNTY, TENNESSEE, THAT:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drink or consume, or have an open can or bottle of beer, or other intoxicating beverage, in or on any public street, alley, avenue, highway, sidewalk, public park, public school ground, or other public place unless the place has a beer or liquor permit and license for on premises consumption.

SECTION II.

Any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars, nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION III.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affect this ordinance.

SECTION IV.

Should any part of this ordinance be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining parts shall be severable and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION V.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its final passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
