ORDINANCE NO. 131

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING ON NARROW STREETS

WHEREAS, parking on certain streets of insufficient width within the Town of Mount Carmel creates a hazard which could lead to property damage, personal injury, or both; and

WHEREAS, the public health, safety, and welfare require it;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE:

SECTION I

Mount Carmel Municipal Code, Title 15, "Motor Vehicles, Traffic and Parking," Chapter 6, "Parking," Section 15-604 is and shall be hereby amended by adding sub-paragraph (14) as follows:

15-604. Where Prohibited. . . . (14) On a street, alley, or other public way which has less than twenty-eight (28) feet paved width.

SECTION II

LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

A. Conflict With Other Ordinances

In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.

B. Validity

If any rule, section, or sub-section of this ordinance is held by any court to be valid or unconstitutional, the same shall not invalidate, otherwise affect any of the other rules, sections, or sub-sections of this ordinance unless it clearly appears that such other rule, section, or sub-section is wholly or necessarily dependent for its operation upon the rule, section, or sub-section so held invalid or unconstitutional.

C. Effective Date

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
