ORDINANCE NO. 265

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MOUNT CARMEL MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 15 "MOTOR VEHICLES, TRAFFIC, AND PARKING", CHAPTER 1 BY ADDING SECTION 15-129.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF The Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

SECTION I. Title 15 "Motor Vehicles, Traffic, and Parking", Chapter 1, "Miscellaneous", shall be amended by adding the following new section 15-129, "Operators to Exercise Care, Maintain Lookout.":

15-129. Operator to Exercise Care, Maintain Lookout. It shall be unlawful to operate a motor vehicle in such manner as shall indicate a failure to keep a proper lookout or an absence of due care, having regard to actual and potential hazards, or when special hazards exist with respect to pedestrians or other traffic, or because of weather or street conditions, and in any event speed and operation shall be so controlled as shall be necessary to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle, or other conveyance on or entering the street or highway in compliance with the legal requirments and the duty of all persons to use due care.

SECTION II. Legal Status Provisions.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
- C. <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
