ORDINANCE NO. 13-397

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013 GENERAL FUND and SEWER FUND BUDGET PASSED BY ORDINANCE NO. 12-376.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel adopted the fiscal year 2012-2013 General Fund budget by passage of Ordinance No. 12-376 on June 26, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel adopted the fiscal year 2012-2013 Sewer Fund budget by passage of Ordinance No. 12-376 on June 26, 2013;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee state constitution, Section 24 of Article II, no public money shall be expended except pursuant to appropriations made by law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Budget Law of 1982, as found in the *Tennessee Code Annotated* §6-56-209, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen has the authority to authorize the budget officer to transfer moneys from one appropriation to another within the same fund; and

WHEREAS, revenue for the General Fund Tax Revenues, Intergovernmental Revenues, Fines and Forfeitures Revenue, and Miscellaneous Revenues will be greater than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, expenses for the Public Safety, Public Works, and Parks and Recreation Expenses will be greater than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund Tax Revenues, Intergovernmental Revenues, Fines and Forfeitures, Miscellaneous Revenues, and Public Safety, Public Works, Parks and Recreation, and the General Fund Balance are housed within the General Fund for the Town; and

WHEREAS, revenue for the Sewer Fund Sewer Operating Revenue, and Non-operating Revenue will be greater than anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Fund Operating Revenue, and Non-Operating Revenue, and the Sewer Fund Balance are housed within the Sewer Fund for the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE THAT CHANGES BE MADE TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-2013 BUDGET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 12-376 is hereby amended by increasing General Fund Tax Revenues by \$37,000; by increasing Intergovernmental Revenue by \$8,100; by increasing Fines and Forfeiture Revenues by \$12,000; and by increasing Miscellaneous Revenues by \$52,900; and by increasing Public Safety expenses by \$40,000; by increasing the Highways and Streets expenses by \$20,000, by increasing Parks and Recreation expenses by \$5,000, and by increasing General Fund Spendable Fund Balance by \$45,000.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 12-376 is hereby amended by increasing Sewer Fund Operating Revenues by \$460; by increasing Sewer Fund Non-Operating Revenues by \$340; and by increasing Sewer Fund Balance by \$800.

SECTION 3. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the City Recorder to make said changes in the accounting system.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
