## **ORDINANCE NO. 18-468**

## AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE DAY OF REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN.

- WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 1-101 of the Mount Carmel Municipal Code, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen holds its regular monthly meeting on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of each month at the City Hall; and
- WHEREAS, members of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen seek a change of the day of the monthly meeting due to other conflicts; and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen deems it in the best interest of the citizens of the Town of Mount Carmel to change the time of the regular meeting of the Board.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF The Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

**SECTION I.** That Chapter 1, Section 1-101 be amended as follows:

1-101. <u>Time and place of regular meetings</u>. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall hold regular meetings at 6:30 p.m. on the fourth (4th) Thursday of each month at City Hall. In case of a conflict with a holiday observed by the Town, or such other good and sufficient reason, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen may set another date and/or time for their regular monthly meeting.

**SECTION II.** Any other Resolution or Ordinance presently in existence which in any way conflicts with any provision is superseded and therefore repealed.

## SECTION III. LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS.

- A. <u>Conflict With Other Ordinances</u>. In case of conflict between this ordinance or any part thereof, and the whole or part of any existing or future ordinance of the Town of Mount Carmel, the most restrictive shall in all cases apply.
- B. <u>Validity</u>. If any section, clause, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held to be in doubt or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, provision, or portion of this ordinance which is not of itself invalid or unconstitutional.
- C. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication, the public welfare requiring it.
