

RESOLUTION NO. 211

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING 1994 GRANT FUNDS FROM THE SWIMMING POOL FUND TO THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel received a grant of \$30,000 from the General Assembly of the State of Tennessee in 1994 through the efforts of State Representative Ken Givens, and

WHEREAS, the \$30,000 grant was intended to upgrade, improve, and build recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen added \$5,000 from the Town's treasury and designated the entire amount to repair the Town's swimming pool, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman now wish to allocate the State grant and Town money for Recreational purposes, now therefore be it


RESOLVED, that the \$35,000, plus accrued interest of over \$2,239, shall be designated for Park and Recreation purposes and shall be used to upgrade, improve, and build Recreational facilities in the Town of Mount Carmel.

THIS Resolution shall become effective immediately, the public welfare demanding it.


