A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING ANY CHANGES OR ALTERATIONS TO ANY MUNICIPAL BUILDING WITHOUT THE AUTHORIZATION FROM THE BUILDING INSPECTOR AND THE SAFETY COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE.

- WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the citizens and employees of the Town of Mount Carmel is of the greatest importance; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the Mount Carmel Board of Mayor and Aldermen any repairs, reconstruction, remodeling, replacement an/or additions to any municipal building is prohibited until written consent has been obtained from the Building Inspector and the Safety Committee Chairman; and
- WHEREAS, any approved repairs, reconstruction, remodeling, replacement and/or additions to any municipal building shall require a building permit from City Hall; and
- WHEREAS, any denial may be brought before the Mount Carmel Board of Mayor and Aldermen; and

WHEREAS, the public welfare requiring it;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

Section I. All repairs, reconstruction, remodeling, replacement and/or additions to any municipal building requires written consent from the Building Inspector and the Safety Committee Chairman.

Section II. A building permit shall be obtained from City Hall for such changes and/or alterations.

Section III. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
