RESOLUTION NO. 299

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE SPEED LIMIT UPON LLOYDS CHAPEL ROAD INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE.

- WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the citizens and employees of the Town of Mount Carmel is of the greatest importance; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to <u>Tenn. Code Anno.</u> §55-8-152 municipalities are authorized to establish speed limits upon any public road of this state within their jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Planning Organization has furnished a traffic study and the Mount Carmel Safety Committee has recommended changing the speed limit from 20 mph to 30 mph on Lloyds Chapel Road; and

WHEREAS, the public welfare requiring it;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

- Section I. The speed limit on Lloyd's Chapel Road is hereby increased from 20 mph and set at 30 mph.
- **Section II.** It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle though Lloyd's Chapel Road at a rate in excess of 30 mph when official signs indicate such speed limits have been posted.

Section III. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
