My interpretation of the State law relating to contributions to non-profit organizations other than charitable organizations, requires following a few steps. In my opinion, contributions to non-profit organizations other than charitable organizations may be made only after notices have been published in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality of the intent to make a contribution to a non-profit, but not charitable, organization specifying the intended amount of the contribution and the purposes for which the contribution will be used.
