A RESOLUTION CONTROLLING TRAFFIC FLOW AROUND MOUNT CARMEL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR INSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE.

- WHEREAS, the safety and well-being of the students, citizens and employees of the Town of Mount Carmel is of the greatest importance; and
- WHEREAS, municipalities are authorized to place traffic control devices upon any public road of this state within their jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS, the Mount Carmel Elementary School, the Mount Carmel Police Department, and the Mount Carmel Safety Committee has recommended changing the route of traffic upon Cherry Street during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. during the school year; and

WHEREAS, the public welfare requiring it;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for ingress traffic to travel westbound on Cherry Street past the Hemlock intersection between the above-noted times as posted; and

Section II. It shall be unlawful for egress traffic to make a left turn from Mount Carmel Elementary School Circle onto Cherry Street between the above-noted times as posted.

Section III. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
