**A RESOLUTION BEFORE THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN
OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$300,000 TO ASSIST IN A PUBLIC
SAFETY BUILDING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman, recognizes the need for a public safety building within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel does not have the financial resources to construct a public safety building without the assistance of grant funds; and

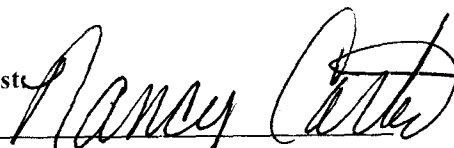
WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman understands that the Tennessee Small Cities' Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program provides assistance to municipalities for this purpose; and

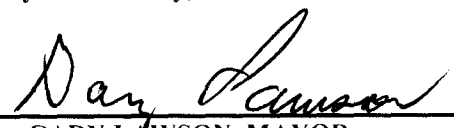
WHEREAS, Tennessee Code annotated Section 8-4-401 authorizes cities and counties to use the CDBG program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Carmel's Board of Mayor and Alderman hereby authorizes the Mayor to make and sign an application for **\$300,000.00** of CDBG funds to assist in the construction of a public safety building at an estimated total cost of **\$483,100**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the matching funds for the project in the amount of **\$183,100** will be provided by the Town of Mount Carmel.
