## A RESOLUTION BEFORE THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000 TO ASSIST IN A PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Alderman, recognizes the need for a public safety building within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel does not have the financial resources to construct a public safety building without the assistance of grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Alderman understands that the Tennessee Small Cities' Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program provides assistance to municipalities for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code annotated Section 8-4-401 authorizes cities and counties to use the CDBG program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town of Mount Carmel's Board of Mayor and Alderman hereby authorizes the Mayor to make and sign an application for \$300,000.00 of CDBG funds to assist in the construction of a public safety building at an estimated total cost of \$483,100.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the matching funds for the project in the amount of \$183,100 will be provided by the Town of Mount Carmel.
