## **RESOLUTION NO. 388**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL TO ESTABLISH A WAR MEMORIAL AT THE CITY PARK AND REQUEST A DEMILITARIZIED COMBAT AIRCRAFT FOR A STATIC DISPLAY.

- WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel wishes to create a war memorial to honor military veterans at the Town's City Park; and
- WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel would like to request a demilitarized combat aircraft from the US Army Tank-automotive and Armaments Life Cycle Management Command to be displayed at said memorial; and
- WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel will assume responsibility for the demilitarization and transportation of said aircraft and will further accept responsibility for the future upkeep of the memorial site and display.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

- Section I. That the Town of Mount Carmel is hereby authorized to apply and accept a donation of a demilitarized combat aircraft from the US Army Tankautomotive and Armaments Life Cycle Management Command to be used as a static display at the city park.
- Section II. If awarded, the Town of Mount Carmel will assume responsibility for the demilitarization and transportation of the vehicle and will further be responsible for the safety and continued upkeep of the war memorial site and display.
- Section III. The Mayor shall do all things necessary to expedite the necessary documentation for the donation and the construction of the memorial. Including, but not limited to, affixing his or his designee's signature thereto;
- **Section IV.** This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage the public welfare requiring it.
