Whereas, our community, our state and our nation, all have benefited greatly from Scouting's high standards of service and duty to God and Country; and

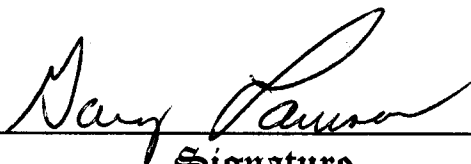
