A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT

- **WHEREAS**, the Town of Mount Carmel is in need of purchasing five (5) new police vehicles and related equipment; and
- WHEREAS, after having been competitively solicited, the City of Murfreesboro has entered into a master contract with Alexander Automotive for the purchase of new police vehicles and related equipment which meet the Town of Mount Carmel's specifications; and
- WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel is able to avail itself of the terms and pricing contained in the master contract; and
- WHEREAS, Alexander Automotive has affirmed their acceptance of the Town of Mount Carmel as an assignee under the master contract for the purchase of five (5) police vehicles and related equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the Alexander Automotive price for the specified vehicles and related equipment includes installation of the related equipment and the State of Tennessee bid price for the vehicles and related equipment does not include installation of the related equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the Alexander Automotive price for the vehicles with installation of the related equipment is below the State of Tennessee bid price for the vehicles and related equipment alone; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available in Retained Earnings for the aforesaid purchases; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Town of Mount Carmel that this resolution be approved. Now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Carmel hereby authorizes and directs the Chief of Police to enter into a contract for the purchase of five (5) new police vehicles and related equipment from Alexander Automotive for a sum not to exceed One Hundred Thirty-One Thousand and Fifty-five Dollars (\$131,055.00).
