

RESOLUTION 19-580

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO REQUEST FUNDING FROM THE TENNESSEE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO PROVIDE HOUSING REHABILITATION FOR LOW-INCOME PERSONS.

WHEREAS, Mount Carmel recognizes the need for housing rehabilitation for low-income residents within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town desires to provide these services to their residents and

WHEREAS, the Mount Carmel Board of Mayor and Alderman understands that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development allows for assistance through the HOME program, administered by the Tennessee Housing Development Agency (THDA), to provide housing rehabilitation for low-income persons.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

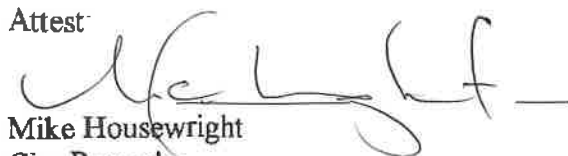
SECTION I: The Board of Mayor and Alderman does hereby authorize the Mayor to file an Application for 2019 HOME funds with THDA in the amount of \$250,000. There are no Town funds required to match the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town of Mount Carmel does hereby authorize the Mayor to sign any and all documents, contracts, assurances, and forms of compliance necessary to effectuate the completion and submittal of the application and that the First Tennessee Development District administer this grant application and grant funds on behalf of the Town.
