A RESOLUTION OF THE MOUNT CARMEL BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN TO DECLARE MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE CITY TO BE SURPLUS TO THE CITY'S NEEDS AND DIRECTING DISPOSAL OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel has identified various equipment from the Mount Carmel Municipal inventory to be surplus to the needs of the city.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

SECTION I: The Board of Mayor and Alderman declare certain equipment of the Mount Carmel Municipal Inventory, which have been withdrawn from the inventory and are no material use in the department, and donated items that are no longer needed, as surplus to the Property declared surplus to the needs of the Town's needs and that the disposal of such materials shall be for the common public benefit.

SECTION II: The City Administrator is hereby directed to sell, recycle, or dispose of the following surplus equipment from the inventory of Mount Carmel property. Firearms; 8 x Glock Model 21 45 caliber pistols, 2004 Nissan Armada, 2011 Dodge Charger.
