



RESOLUTION NO. 22-615

TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE

A RESOLUTION OF THE MOUNT CARMEL BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN FOR MEMBERS TO ATTEND A MINIMUM OF TWELVE HOURS OF TRAINING AND CONTINUING EDUCATION WITHIN ONE YEAR OF INITIAL APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION.

WHEREAS, The Tennessee Comptroller of the Treasury requires utility board training for certain municipal elected officials under Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) § 7-34-115(j)(1)

WHEREAS, Municipal board members attend a minimum of twelve hours of training and continuing education in the approved subject matter within one year of initial appointment or election to the board or within one year of reappointment or reelection to the board.

WHEREAS, Municipal board members are required to obtain twelve hours of training every three years thereafter. The first three-year period begins the January 1st after the calendar year in which the board member completes the initial one-year training period. Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-34-115(j)(2)-(3)(B)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

SECTION I: The Board of Mayor and Alderman within one year of initial appointment or election to complete Level 1 of the Municipal Technical Advisory Service, Elected Officials Academy. Foundations of Government; Charters, Codes, & Local Legislative Acts: Ethics, Open Meetings, Public Records: How to Conduct Effective Meetings; Municipal Finance: Human Resources, Strategic Planning, Panel of Elected Officials or training in the approved subject matter in order to meet the requirements of (TCA) § 7-34-115(j)(1)
