A RESOLUTION OF THE MOUNT CARMEL BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN TO DECLARE MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE TOWN TO BE SURPLUS TO THE TOWN'S NEEDS AND DIRECTING DISPOSAL OF SAME.

WHEREAS, the Town of Mount Carmel has identified various equipment from the Mount Carmel Municipal inventory to be surplus to the needs of the town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMAN OF THE TOWN OF MOUNT CARMEL, TENNESSEE, as follows:

SECTION I: The Board of Mayor and Alderman declare certain equipment of the Mount Carmel Municipal Inventory, which have been withdrawn from the inventory and are no material use in the department, and donated items that are no longer needed, as surplus to the Property declared surplus to the needs of the Town's needs and that the disposal of such materials shall be for the common public benefit.

SECTION II: The Town Administrator is hereby directed to sell, recycle, or dispose of the following surplus equipment from the inventory of Mount Carmel property. 3101 New Holland side sling manure spreader; 2500 ORTEC belt press; Bobcat 1856; 1990 Pierce arrow 55' firetruck; Vector 150 Amp Battery Charger; band saw; 2 x FS120 weed eater; FS81 weed eater; Homelite HX16 hedge trimmer; Stihl woodboss chainsaw; Pressure washer; Tractor broom; 4 x round tables with chairs.
