

RESOLUTION NO 625

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A BRUSH AND LARGE ITEM COLLECTION POLICY

- WHEREAS,** the removal of bulk waste presents a potential hazard to those operating vehicles on the streets of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, and;
- WHEREAS,** the removal of such bulk waste presents a fiscal hardship for the Town of Mount Carmel, and;
- WHEREAS,** the current procedure for the removal of such bulk waste results in mismanagement of the time of the employees of the Town of Mount Carmel, and;
- WHEREAS,** the regulation of such bulk waste removal is necessary in order to appropriately manage the resources allocated for waste pick-up;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN of the Town of Mount Carmel, Tennessee, as follows:

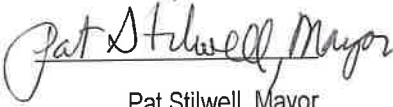
SECTION I. Collection of brush, leaves, and grass clippings will occur daily. Collection will occur by route whereas the truck will travel each street within the city limits within a one-month time period. Tree brush must be less than 14ft in length and 14in. in diameter. Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged.

SECTION II. Special collection of certain household items and appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, water tanks, washing machines, dryers, furniture, mattresses, bedsprings, and oversized cardboard boxes shall be collected by the town as follows:

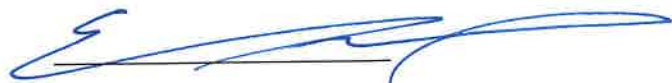
- a. Special collection of these items will be made by appointment only. The last full week of the month will be designated for pickup of large items other than brush.
- b. Upon scheduling pickup of large items, a collection fee of \$50.00 will be assessed prior to pick up.
- c. The removal of any whole or part of such material that the town determines it cannot safely remove according to the terms and limitations of this sub-section shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner or resident upon notification. If removal does not occur by the following pickup, the owner could be subject to code enforcement citations.
- d. For one week, no more than 2 times per year in April and October, the town will pick up additional items such as boxes, pallets, or other items that cannot be broken down and placed in trash can, free of charge.

SECTION II. Prohibited items shall include any debris left from contractors, overflow household trash, tires, oil, antifreeze, rims, vehicle parts, batteries, paint, carpet, bricks or construction materials, microwaves, air conditioners, concrete, shingles, and any other items established by the Hawkins County Landfill.
